The dissident practices and sociabilities of the late GDR unfolded in a present detached from any utopian future. To this day, these historical experiences have not been acknowledged or studied as relevant. The materials at the Archive of the GDR Opposition, draw a complex picture of oppositional women*s, peace, and environmental movements, and gay and lesbian initiatives. The institution was founded in 1990 by protagonists of some of these groups. The invited artists and authors trace their histories and their projections relating them to concepts and forms of the Political in the present day.
